As we enter the colder months, I know the cost of living and the rising costs of energy is worrying many people. Recently, I hosted a Winter Support Summit with local organisations across the area to discuss how we can work together to help people access support in the coming months.

One of the main themes from the summit was that there is a wide range of support, however, we need to make it easier for people to access this support. That is why I have created this guide, in order to assist in signposting people to help including the action the government is taking, to help households with energy bills.

- The £400 energy bills rebate available to every household
- Keeping energy bills as low as possible this winter with the Energy Price Guarantee

- £300 cost of living support for pensioners who receive the Winter Fuel Payment
- Support for households which are not on the grid.

SUPPORT FOR THOSE ON

MEANS-TESTED BENEFITS

For information on the Energy Price Guarantee, the £400 energy bill rebate and support for households which are not on the gas grid, visit **helpforhouseholds.campaign.gov.uk**.

SUPPORT FOR PENSIONERS

Every household on means-tested benefits will receive a £650 cost-of-living payment in 2022 and a £900 cost-of-living payment in 2023, supporting low-income households.

This includes all households receiving the following support;

- Universal Credit
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Income Support
- Working Tax Credit
- Child Tax Credit
- Pension Credit

To check whether you are eligible for this funding, visit **gov.uk/cost-of-living** or call **01507 601111**.

If you receive Disability Living Allowance or Attendance Allowance, you could receive £150 in 2022 and again in 2023.

From April 2023, benefits will also increase in line with inflation of 10.1%. For an average family on Universal Credit this will be an uplift of around £600.

If you're of State Pension Age and on a low income you could qualify for Pension Credit.

The average Pension Credit payment is worth more than £3,000 a year and it is possible to qualify even if you own your own home or have savings.

From April 2023, Pension Credit will rise by 10.1% in line with inflation which is worth up to \pounds 1,470 for a couple and \pounds 960 for a single pensioner. The State Pension will also increase in line with inflation by 10.1% - an \pounds 870 increase.

Check if you are eligible by visiting **gov.uk/pension-credit-calculator** or call **01507 601111**.

From the autumn, eight million pensioner households who receive the Winter Fuel Payment will also receive an extra, one-off Pensioner Cost of Living Payment of £300. They will also receive another £300 one-off payment in 2023. You can find out more about the Winter Fuel Payment and Cost of Living Payment at **gov.uk/winter-fuel-payment**.
